Storyline

• Maryland, the co-champion of the Atlantic Coast Conference regular season, advanced to a second-round matchup Sunday with 12th-ranked Michigan State with an 89-77 victory over Houston. It was Maryland's 10th straight victory in a first-round game in the NCAA Tournament.

• Maryland's 89 points was tied for 7th on the highest-scoring outputs the Terrapins had in an NCAA Tournament game. The Terps scored 50 points in the second half with a strong performance at the free-throw line. Maryland hit 21 of 25 foul shots (.840) in the game, including 18 of 21 (.857) in the second half.

• Freshman Jordan Williams had his best effort of the season against the Cougars on Friday. He posted career-highs in points (21) and rebounds (17). His 17 boards were the third-most ever by a Maryland player in an NCAA Tournament game. Williams' double-double was his 7th of the season. It was his 6th game with double figures on the boards in last nine.

• Senior guard Greivis Vasquez, the 2010 ACC Player of the Year, had 16 points, seven rebounds and six assists Friday against the Cougars. Vasquez, with 2,145 career points, is now four points from tying Len Bias (2,149, 1983-86) for second place on the Terps' all-time scoring list. Juan Dixon has the school record (2,269, 1999-02).

• Maryland, ranked 20th last week, will be attempting to advance to the Sweet Sixteen for the 14th time in history. The Terps have been to the regional semifinals seven times in the last 16 years, including three times since 2001 (2001, 2002, 2003). The Terrapins won the NCAA National Championship in 2002.

Quick Team Hits

- Maryland has won 8 of its last 9 and 10 of its last 12... A 25th win would be the 9th occurrence in school history (7th under Gary Williams).
- Maryland's +21 rebounding edge over Houston on Friday matched a season-best for the Terps (54-33 at UNC Greensboro, 1/3).
- Maryland is now 20-0 this season when leading at the half.
- Shooting .818 (90-for-110) from FT line in last 5 games... Terps have had eight straight games with 12 turnovers or less.
- Gary Williams is now 5th among active Division I coaches with 649 victories, breaking the tie with Houston's Tom Penders.

Maryland vs. Ranked Teams Under Gary Williams

Since Gary Williams took over in 1989-90, Maryland has 72 wins over Top 25 teams, including a 79-72 win over #4 Duke recently:

- Williams is the nation's winningest active coach vs. top-ranked teams with seven career victories over a No. 1 opponent (6 at Maryland; 1 at Ohio State).
- Under Williams, Maryland has defeated 20 Top 5 opponents, 34 Top 10 opponents and the No. 1 team 6 times.
- Maryland has 23 wins over Top 10 teams the last 10 years.
- The Terps have defeated at least one Top 10 opponent in 17 of 21 seasons under Williams, including 14 straight.
- Williams has led victories over 1st-, 2nd- or 3rd-ranked teams in 8 of the last 10 seasons.

Fear the Turtle!

Maryland is one of the most consistent winning programs in the country following more than a decade of excellence:

- The Terps have averaged 23.0 wins per season the last 14 years, including eight consecutive 20-win seasons from 1996-2004.
- Maryland has 17 straight postseason appearances, including 11 consecutive trips to the NCAA TOURNAMENT from 1993-2004.

• The Terrapins have won at least two postseason games (ACC, NCAA, NIT) in 9 of the last 11 seasons, including a 3-2 mark last year.

• The Terps have advanced to the NCAA SWEET SIXTEEN 7 times in the last 16 years... The Terps are 9th nationally in the number of Sweet Sixteen appearances since 1994.

- Maryland made consecutive trips to the NCAA FINAL FOUR in 2001 and 2002 .
- The Terps captured the 2002 NCAA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.
- The Terps captured the 2004 ACC TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP.
- Maryland tied for the REGULAR-SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP in the ACC in 2010.

Commitment To Education

Under Gary Williams, the Maryland basketball program continues to place a high priority on education and the personal growth of its student-athletes. Maryland has graduated eight of its last 10 seniors and all four current seniors (Jerome Burney, Greivis Vasquez, Eric Hayes, Landon Milbourne) are on track to earn their degrees this season.

Burney has been named the recipient of the LeFrak Scholarship Award. The scholarship represents an endowment established by the Samuel J. and Ethel LeFrak Foundation, and is awarded annually to three Maryland student-athletes who exhibit extraordinary athletic, leadership and scholarship abilities.

Many former Terps continue to work toward their degrees while continuing to pursue professional basketball opportunities. Keith Booth, a four-year starter and 1997 All-American, graduated in 2003 after pursuing a professional basketball career that included winning an NBA Championship in 1998, and is now one of Gary Williams' assistant coaches. Former Terps Calvin McCall, Laron Profit and Terrell Stokes are among the recent men's basketball players to earn degrees from the University of Maryland. Maryland student-athletes all work toward completion of their college degree with the assistance of the Academic Support and Career Development Unit.

#1 - Landon Milbourne (Sr., F, Roswell, Ga.)

- In his last 2 games, has 34 points and 13 boards (15 pts, 6 rebs vs. GT at ACCT).
- Needs 1 block to become 12th Terp in history with 100 in his career... Leads team in blocked shots (39)
- 21 games in double figures this season.
- Has started 66 straight games.
- 2nd on team in scoring (12.7 ppg), 3rd on team in rebounding (5.0)... One of 3 Terps averaging 5.0 rpg.
- His 19 points on Friday doubled his scoring total in two previous NCAA games (17).

#5 - Eric Hayes (Sr., G, Woodbridge, Va.)

- 4th on Maryland career 3-point FG list (192).
- 6th on career assist list (506)... Next on list is John Lucas (514, 1973-76).
- Team-best 2.38 assist-turnover ratio this season (6 assists, 2 turnovers vs. Houston on Friday).
- Scored in double figures in last 7 games (13.0 ppg), 8 of last 9 and 12 of the last 14.
- Career FT percentage of .869 would lead all-time list at Maryland (Greg Manning, .858, 1978-81).
- 23 games this season with double-figure scoring... 13 games with 5 assists or more.

#14 - Sean Mosley (So., G, Baltimore, Md.)

- 2nd on team in rebounding with 5.2 rpg... 18 games with at least 5 rebounds.
- 22-for-23 FT (.957) in last 5 games... Has hit last 19 straight FTs.
- 2nd on team in steals with 44.
- One of four Terps averaging in double figures (10.3 ppg).

#20 - Jordan Williams (Fr., F, Torrington, Conn.)

- His 17 rebounds in the first-round win over Houston were the most by any player in the first round.
- His 21 points were the most by a freshman big man in the first round of the Tournament.
- Averaging 12.9 points, 10.4 rebounds over his last 9 games (4 double-doubles)... .536 FG% (45-for-84).
- Season-highs in points (21), rebounds (17), FG (9), FGA (14) in first-round win over Houston.
- Now with 7 double-doubles on season, 12 games in double-figure scoring and 12 games in double-figure rebounding.
- Has at least 5 rebounds in 31 of Terps' 32 games this season (team-high 8.6 rpg).
- One of only two Terp freshman with at least 250 points and 250 boards (Joe Smith, Buck Williams).

#21 - Greivis Vasquez (Sr., G, Caracas, Venezuela)

- Averaging 22.9 ppg in his last 9 games (Terps are 8-1).
- Needs 4 points to tie Len Bias (2,149, 1983-86) for 2nd on career scoring list.
- 50-for-51 at FT line (.980) in last 7 games.
- 28 straight games with double-figure scoring.
- 621 points rank 13th on single-season list at Maryland (Keith Booth, 624, 1997 is next).
- Now with 200 assists, 9th time in school history that's been reached (Vasquez had 231 in 2008).
- Now with 764 career assists, he ranks 9th on ACC's all-time list... (Kenny Smith, UNC is 8th, 768, 1984-87)... Just passed NC State's Sidney Lowe (762, 1980-83).

#22 - Adrian Bowie (Jr., G, Greenbelt, Md.)

- Only 25 turnovers in 32 games this season (1.88 assist-turnover ratio).
- 9 points in Friday win over Houston (2-for-3 behind arc).
- 14-for-18 (.778) from floor in last 5 games.
- Scored 31 points with 11 rebounds in 59 minutes over last 4 games.

#24 - Cliff Tucker (Jr., G, El Paso, Texas)

- His 7 rebounds in NCAA First-Round win over Houston were season-high (previous was 5) and tied a career-high.
- Hitting .497 from the floor this season.

#33 - Dino Gregory (Jr., F, Baltimore, Md.)

- Hitting .800 from FT line this season after shooting .536 last year.
- Hit 22 of his last 27 at foul line (.815) over last 14 games.
- 4 of his 8 games with at least 5 boards have come in last 6 outings.

Head Coach Gary Williams

- 649-365 (.640) in 32 seasons overall.
- 442-237 (.651) in 21 seasons at Maryland.
- 29-15 (.659) in 14 NCAA appearances overall (25-12, .676, while at Maryland).
