

# **Emergency Plan: Indoor Practice Facility**

*Revised 3/31/05*

**Emergency Personnel:** certified athletic trainers, student athletic trainers, and physician (limited basis) on site in athletic training facility, located on the west side of the field.

**Emergency Communication:** fixed phone line in IPF athletic training facility (662-915-1857)

**Emergency Equipment:** emergency equipment (AED, frac pack, vacuum splints, spine board) located within athletic training facility located on the first floor.

## **Roles of First Responders**

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Emergency equipment retrieval
1. Activation of emergency medical system (EMS)
  - a. 9-911 call (provide name, address, telephone number; number of individuals injured; condition of injured; first aid treatment; specific directions; other information as requested)
  - b. campus police (662-915-7234) respond to all 911 calls
2. Direction of EMS to scene
  - a. open appropriate gates
  - b. designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to scene
  - c. scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area

**Venue Directions:** located off Hill Drive on Manning Way, behind football practice fields. The following entrances provide the most direct access to the building:

1. Weight room: enter through the rolling door located on the east side of the facility.
2. Indoor field: enter through the rolling door located on the south side of the facility.
3. Athletic training room and locker room: enter through doors located on the west side of the facility.
