

Emergency Plan: Patricia C. Lamar National Guard Readiness Center

Emergency Personnel: UMAA rifle coach on site for practice and competitions (current CPR/AED certification)

Emergency Communication: coach carries cellular telephone (662-816-1409)

Emergency Equipment: limited first aid kit on site, emergency equipment (AED, oxygen, frac pack, vacuum splints) transported to course for tournaments

Role of First Responders:

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Emergency equipment retrieval
1. Activation of emergency medical system (EMS)
 - a. 911 call (provide name, address, telephone number, number of individuals injured; condition of injured; first aid treatment; specific directions; other information as requested)
2. Direction of EMS to scene
 - a. open appropriate gates
 - b. designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to scene
 - c. scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area

Venue Directions: located at 102 Ed Perry Blvd at the intersection of Sisk Avenue and Highway 7. Enter rifle range through the first door located on the left side of the front of the building.
