

Emergency Plan: Rebel Soccer Stadium

Emergency Personnel: certified athletic trainer on site for practice and competition; additional sports medicine staff accessible from Gillom Sports Center athletic training facility

Emergency Communication: certified athletic trainer carries cellular telephone (662-801-7654); fixed telephone line located in press box (662-915-7851); additional telephone line located in Gillom Sports Center athletic training facility (662-915-5297)

Emergency Equipment: emergency equipment (AED, frac pack, vacuum splints, spine board) located in the Gillom Sports Center athletic training facility

Roles of First Responders

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Emergency equipment retrieval
3. Activation of emergency medical system (EMS)
 - a. 9-911 call (provide name, address, telephone number; number of individuals injured; condition of injured; first aid treatment; specific directions; other information as requested)
 - b. campus police (662-915-7234) respond to all 911 calls
4. Direction of EMS to scene
 - a. open appropriate gates and doors
 - b. designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to scene
 - c. scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area

Venue Directions: located at the corner of Coliseum Drive and Hawthorne Road at the rear of the Gillom Sports Center:

1. Primary entrance: enter the Gillom Sports Center parking lot and drive to the end; take drive around the side of the facility and enter field through gate located next to the scoreboard
