KIAWAH ISLAND, S.C. -- Senior Pope Spruiell tied for 10th overall with a score of 68-76--144, but Ole Miss took a tumble from the top spot, finishing eighth at the Cleveland Golf/Kiawah Island Intercollegiate with a score of 292-306--598.

Spruiell's top-10 finish marked the second of his career. He placed fifth at the same tournament to open the 2002-03 season.

Junior David Shields carded the second-best finish for the Rebels, tying for 23rd with a 73-75--148. Junior Jarrod Gardner was next for Ole Miss, firing a 75-75--150 to tie for 29th individually.

Freshman Kyle Ellis, who was competing in his first collegiate tournament, carded a two-day total of 79-80--159.

Freshman Chris Rogers turned in a first-round score of 76, but was disqualified from the tournament after signing the wrong scorecard at the conclusion of Tuesday's action.

Freshman Chris Rogers and senior Pope Spruiell led the way for Ole Miss with both players tying for 35th in the individual standings. The duo fired identical rounds of 73-72-77--222 for the tournament.

NEW ORLEANS, La. -- The Ole Miss men's golf team finished sixth out of nine teams at the 2004 Nokia Sugar Bowl/Tulane Invitational. After firing rounds of 294 and 302 at the English Turn Golf and Country Club Monday, the Rebels shot a 306 Tuesday to finish with a score of 902 for the two-day affair.

Redshirt freshman Chris Rogers led the Rebels with a 13th-place finish (69-79-76--224). Junior David Shields turned in a 20th-place effort (79-71-77--227), while freshman Kyle Ellis (74-77-78--229) and junior Jarrod Gardner (79-75-75--229) tied for 26th place overall.
