2002 SEC TOURNAMENT

Oxford, Miss. (Ole Miss Soccer Stadium)

FIRST ROUND (Thursday, 7:30 p.m. CST):
vs. KENTUCKY (10-7, 4-4 SEC)



- A first-time host, Ole Miss is making its sixth straight SEC Tournament appearance — the longest streak of any Western Division team. The Rebels have advanced to the semifinals two of the last three years. The best finish was a runner-up performance to Florida in 1999.
- With a 13-3-2 overall record, the Rebels finished the regular season with their best winning percentage ever (.778) and are now only one victory shy of matching their highest single-season win total.
- Ole Miss is currently at its highest regional ranking (fifth in NSCAA) and best national ranking at 26th (first among teams receiving votes) in the latest NSCAA poll.
- UM head coach **Steve Holeman** has been with the program since its inception in 1994 and boasts an 85-65-7 overall mark in eight seasons. He has guided the Rebels to the SEC West's best record over the last six seasons (70-44-6).
- The Rebels will honor seniors **Kristin Chapman** and **Anna Sanders** in a brief ceremony immediately following the 5 p.m. match between Georgia and Tennessee.

OPENING ROUND: Ole Miss faces off with Kentucky for the second time this season in Thursday's first-round encounter. The Rebels pulled off a 1-0 victory over the Lady Kats on Oct. 18 in Lexington. **Kelly Renie** netted the game-winner, and **Brittany Gillespie** turned away seven shots in the shutout. It was Ole Miss' first ever win against UK, snapping a five-game skid. Kentucky eliminated the Rebels from the 1997 SEC Tournament with a 4-1 opening-round triumph. Thursday's match marks the fifth time Ole Miss has faced an opponent during the regular season and again in the conference tournament with splits in every instance.

POSTSEASON HONORS: **Kelly Renie** was named the 2002 SEC Soccer Freshman of the Year and joined sophomore teammate **Kristal Menard** on the All-SEC first team Wednesday night, as announced at the SEC Tournament Awards Banquet in Oxford. It was the first all-conference selection for either player. Renie is the first Rebel to earn SEC Freshman of the Year honors and second Ole Miss athlete to claim the award in the last year, joining Seth Smith from baseball in the spring. Ole Miss was one of only four teams with two players on the all-conference first team. Raising their all-time All-SEC selection total to nine, the Rebels have had at least one first team honoree each of the last six seasons.

REBEL MILESTONES: With a 13-3-2 record, Ole Miss is in the midst of its best season in the program's eight-year history and has already achieved numerous UM firsts. On Sept. 23, the Rebels reached their highest ever regional ranking at fifth (*Soccer Buzz*) and kept the spot for two straight weeks. Ole Miss returned to the five spot on the NSCAA region poll the last two weeks. The last two weeks of September also saw Ole Miss receive votes in the top-25 polls for the first time. The Rebels picked up votes on the 24th in the *Soccer Buzz* rankings and on the 30th, were third among teams earning votes in *Soccer Buzz* and sixth in *Soccer Times* (seven votes). Ole Miss received its highest vote total this week, ranking first among other teams in the NSCAA poll. In addition, UM opened the year at 8-0-1, tying the school record for longest unbeaten streak. Ole Miss was the last undefeated team in the SEC and one of the final 11 in Division I.

SCORING MACHINE The 2002 SEC Freshman of the Year and an All-SEC first team recipient, **Kelly Renie** has been one of the nation's best offensive players thus far in 2002. The redshirt freshman from Carmel, Ind., ranks second in the SEC in total points (39) and goals (18), and is 18th in the nation in points per game (2.17) and tied for 12th in goals per game (1.00). Renie has provided the game-winner in nine of the 13 UM victories, and she has found the back of the net eight times in SEC play with 16 overall points — both lead the league. Her 18 overall goals is already the second-highest single-season total in school history. Renie, who missed the entire 2001 campaign with a torn ACL, has registered five multiple-goal performances, including her first career hat trick at Colorado.

NO GOALS FOR YOU: A big part of the Rebels' 2002 success can be attributed to the Ole Miss defense and **Brittany Gillespie**. The junior from Modesto, Calif., is having the finest season ever by a UM goalkeeper and set to finish the campaign with a few records under her belt. Prior to the Tennessee game, Gillespie recorded three consecutive blankings of Kentucky, Vanderbilt and Georgia to create a new UM season high for shutouts (7.5). The 3-0 victory over Georgia established a new season record for GK victories (12). With a 1.00 goals-against average, Gillespie is 0.31 ahead of the Ole Miss season record, and her current 1.05 career GAA puts her atop the Rebel all-time list. Gillespie is second in the SEC in shutouts in both all games and league games only, and she also ranks top four in GAA and saves in both categories.

A YEAR BETTER: With the Oct. 11 victory at Alabama, Ole Miss matched its win total from a year ago, and a number of 2001 offensive marks have also been bested. The Rebels have already exceeded last season's goal total by seven and the assist total by seven. **Kelly Renie's** 18 goals is 11 more than an Rebel recorded last year, and her 39 points is over twice as many as the '01 individual-high of 18. The current team goals-against average of 0.96 marks an improvement of 0.34 from a season ago, and the eight shutouts broke last year's record number. Ole Miss was shut out six times in 2001, but was held scoreless only once this season in the 0-0 tie at Vanderbilt.

INJURY REPORT: Senior **Courtney Biddle**, who ranks top 10 in UM career points, goals and assists, suffered a torn anterior cruciate ligament during the first week of preseason, and will miss the remainder of the season after undergoing surgery on Oct. 9. In addition, freshman **Brittney Potts**, who started the first three games at forward, went down with the same injury 1:46 into the Kansas game. Potts will also not return this year and is the fifth Ole Miss player to go down with a torn ACL over the last two seasons.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **Karen Hall** was named the Southeastern Conference Player of the Week on Sept. 23 and later named to the *Soccer America* Team of the Week. A sophomore from Southlake, Texas, Hall led the Rebels to a perfect 2-0 road week-end, assisting on both last-minute, game-winning scores while also netting three goals. Against Southwest Missouri State, Hall came off the bench to register her first career multiple-goal performance, in addition to setting up the game-winner with 42 seconds left in regulation. She also picked up a goal and assist in a 2-1 overtime victory at Mizzou.

TOURNAMENT WINNERS Ole Miss won its fourth straight regular season tournament this season at the Rebels' own Ole Miss Invitational in Oxford, Miss. The Rebels went 2-0 against Marshall, 2-0, and Georgia State, 3-2, to take first place in the event.
