### REBELS CONTINUE HOMESTAND WITH 'BACKS

Ole Miss continues a six-game SEC West homestand with Arkansas in a mid-week softball series. Wednesday's doubleheader and Thursday's finale begin at 5 p.m. CST each day at Ole Miss Softball Complex. The Rebels (23-19, 5-13 SEC) enter the series 1.5 games out of the eighth and final spot for the SEC Tournament and matched up with a Lady Razorback team (29-21, 8-13 SEC) that currently sits seventh. Ole Miss will be looking to snap a season-long six-game losing streak, coming off series sweeps to Division foes Alabama and Mississippi State last week. Despite the loss to the 15th-ranked Tide, the Rebels have been strong at home, recording an 11-6 mark on the season. Ole Miss has produced SEC series wins over Kentucky and Florida in Oxford.

### SERIES INFO

Arkansas has taken the last 11 meetings for a 17-2 all-time series advantage, but only with a 3-1 average margin of victory. The Rebels' only wins came in a 2-2 series split in 1998 in Oxford (*more below*).

### LAST TIME OUT

The Rebels suffered their first home series loss of the season last weekend, dropping all three games with No. 15 Alabama. In the opener, Ole Miss hung within a run of its first-ranked opponent of the season until Alabama broke it open with a three-run fourth inning for the 5-1 win. The Rebels narrowed the lead to 2-1 in the second inning, when **Jessica Hamilton** singled to left field to plate **DeDe Justice**. However, UA All-American Shelley Laird would limit Ole Miss to only one other hit over six innings. Laird would team with Jennifer Wright and Erin Wright to quiet the Rebel bats again in game two, allowing three hits in the 4-0 combined shutout. **Lindsey Whatley** was the tough-luck loser in the complete-game outing. In the finale, Ole Miss wrecked Laird's no-hit bid and loaded the bases in the seventh inning but was unable to plate a run in dropping 3-0 defeat.

### SCOUTING REPORT

Arkansas has won four of its last five contests and is fresh off a 2-1 series victory against Tennessee last weekend in Fayetteville. Senior hurler Rachel Talley has

battled some arm injuries that slowed her on the mound, but she compensated with a .625 week at the plate including two game-winning hits. Sophomore Heather Schlichtman threw the bulk of the innings last week, allowing just five earned runs in 22.1 innings while striking out 22 for the Lady 'Backs. The 2001 All-SEC second team righthander currently ranks in the top 10 in the conference in wins (13-7), ERA (1.54) and strikeouts (134), and leads a UA staff that is second best in the league with a 1.44 team ERA.

### TOUGH-LUCK LADIES

While the Rebel offense has struggled during the recent six-game skid, the Ole Miss pitching staff has remained solid with a 3.05 ERA over that stretch. The Rebels were on the short end of a pair of 1-0 pitchers' duels in the MSU series. Junior **Leslie Day**, who ranks in the SEC's top 10 in league-play ERA, was the tough luck loser in the opener, limiting the Bulldogs to three hits with six strikeouts in the complete game. **Lindsey Whatley** scattered six hits and the lone State run in the finale. Despite an 0-2 mark, Whatley surrendered only two earned runs in two complete games last week, registering a 1.08 ERA. The Rebels have been held score-

less in five of the six losses for the freshman righthander from Huntsville, Ala.

### STREAKING REBELS

The 2002 season has been one of streaks for Ole Miss. The Rebels have had five stretches of four or more wins or losses. They opened the season winning four-in-a-row, earning the program's first ever 4-0 start. From Mar. 16-Mar. 26, Ole Miss recorded a nine-game winning streak, tying a three-year-old school record. The Rebels batted .410 during the streak and outscored their opponents, 73-9. However, the Rebels suffered through four-game skids immediately prior to and following the record nine-game run. Ole Miss is currently enduring a season-long six-game losing streak.

### STRICTLY CONFERENCE

It's SEC only for Ole Miss for the remainder of its 2002 schedule. The Rebels are facing the third of seven straight conference series, including five against teams that have been ranked in the nation's top 25, leading up to the SEC Tournament, May 9-12 in Chattanooga, Tenn.

### BEST SEASON YET

The Rebels remain in the midst of the best season in the program's six-year history. Ole Miss needs only four more victories to surpass the school record for wins in a season set in 1999. That year also marked the only other time the Rebels have maintained an above .500 mark this late in the year. With the Mar. 26 sweep of Jackson State, Ole Miss reached the 20-win plateau faster than any previous UM team. Proof of the turnaround is visible in the unprecedented statistics. The single-season school record for homers fell after only 17 games, and now the season highs for runs (20 away), RBI (16 away) and walks (9 away) are in sight. The club in also on pace to set new standards for batting average (three points higher at .250) and earned run average (46 points lower at 1.98). In addition, the Rebels set or tied UM single-game records for hits, runs and RBI in the 20-0 shellacking of JSU, which also gave Ole Miss its record-tying ninth-straight win.

### POWER SURGE

The 2002 Rebels are ripping the ball out of the park and destroying the UM record book in the process. With 22 home runs as a team, the Rebels have already exceeded the club total of the previous two seasons combined, including the former single-season high of nine set in 2000. The current Ole Miss squad broke that record in this season's 17th contest - game one of the Tennessee series, in which the Rebels blasted three round-trippers

to set a new single-game standard. That matchup also saw **DeDe Justice** establish a new individual season record with her sixth homer. The freshman catcher now boasts nine and needs only three more to eclipse UM career-leader Heather Swinney's 11 bombs. Ole Miss enters the weekend tied for fourth in the SEC in home runs as a team, while Justice ranks fifth individually.

### CAREER HIGHS ... ALREADY

Junior **Phyllis Manley** has recorded 10 RBI, exceeding the combined total of six from her first two years in Oxford ... Sophomore outfielder **Britte Hardy** boasts seven stolen bases (in nine attempts) after swiping only two in 2001 ... In the UK series, junior righthander **Lindsay Price** earned her fifth victory, matching her season-high for wins set in 2001.

### TOURNEY CHAMPS

Ole Miss collected a pair of tournament titles this season. The Rebels captured first place at the season-opening UNM Diamond Invitational in Albuquerque, N.M., as well as taking the crown at their own tourney, the Rebel/Easton Invitational.

### GREATEST COMEBACK

In the Rebels' 10-9 season-opening win over New Mexico, Ole Miss rallied from its largest deficit ever, coming back from 6-0 down to win in 11 innings, which also tied the longest game in Rebel history.
