REBELS TAKE 9-GAME WIN STREAK TO THE PLAINS

The Ole Miss Rebels (20-8, 3-3 SEC) battle the Auburn Tigers (23-15, 2-7 SEC) in a three-game set this weekend in Auburn. The series marks the first Southeastern Conference Western Division action for both teams. The Rebels roll into the weekend in the midst of a nine-game winning streak, matching the longest in school history. Ole Miss swept Kentucky at home last weekend to even its league mark at 3-3. The Tigers picked up their first two wins in league play this week, taking two of three at Florida. However, Auburn remains at the bottom of the SEC West standings and two and a half games behind fourth-place Ole Miss. Sunday's game marks both team's first televised game of the year. Ole Miss dropped its lone TV game a year ago, losing at Florida on SEC-TV.

LAST TIME OUT

Ole Miss wrapped up a five-game homestand on Tuesday with a doubleheader domination of Jackson State, 12-1 and 20-0. The 20-0 blanking in game two marked Ole Miss' second-largest margin of victory and second-highest run total ever, falling short only of the 22-1 blowout of Mississippi Valley State in the Rebels' inaugural 1997 season. Ole Miss notched a UM single-game record 20 hits in the late game, led by **DeDe Justice** who tied the individual record for hits with four and runs scored with four. Justice and **Nicole Alger** each drove in five runs to set a new individual game-high for RBI. **Leslie Day** (7-3) limited the Lady Tigers (18-12) to three hits with a personal-best 12 strikeouts over five innings in her third shutout.

In game one, JSU struck first with a second-inning homer, but Ole Miss rebounded with a seven-run third, keyed by **Andrea Brahs'** RBI-double and **Jessica Hamilton's** two-run single. Brahs and **Desiree Layman** each batted 3-for-3 and scored three times. Layman notched six hits in the twin bill. Alger improved to 2-0 on the mound this year.

SCOUTING REPORT

After starting 20-7, Auburn has won only three of its last 11 entering this series. However, the Tigers bounced back from sweeps to Georgia and Arkansas to earn a 2-1 series win at Florida this week. Freshman Sara Dean provided the offensive spark for AU, batting 6-for-10 with a home run and seven RBI in the Gator series. Dean and All-America outfielder Ashley Moore have led the Tiger attack this season, batting .364 and .319 respectively, with 20 RBI apiece. Moore is tied for the league lead in home runs with 10. Sophomore righthander Kristin Keyes tops the Auburn staff with a 10-7 mark, 1.83 ERA and three shutouts.

SERIES INFO

Although trailing the all-time series 13-6, Ole Miss has won five of eight against Auburn on the Plains (*more below*). Overall, the teams have split their last four meetings with the Rebels taking the finale of the last two series. After dropping a 10-inning affair in game two last year, Ole Miss rebounded for a 3-2 win on Sunday, using a pair of **Desiree Layman** singles and a couple AU errors to slide by the Tigers. Junior **Phyllis Manley** boasts a .389 (7-for-19) career average vs. the Tigers.

TWO MONTHS FOR THE AGES

The Rebels are finishing up the finest two-month period in the softball program's six-year history. With Tuesday's sweep of Jackson State, Ole Miss reached the 20-win plateau faster than any previous UM team. The Rebels are off to their best start ever, and posting offensive totals unprecedented by an Ole Miss squad. The single-season school record for homers fell after only 17 games, and now the season highs for runs (35 away) and RBI (27 away) are easily in sight. On Tuesday, the Rebels set or tied UM single-game records for hits, runs, homers and RBI in the 20-0 shellacking of JSU, which also gave Ole Miss its record-tying ninth-straight win. The team is seven games better than its 13-15 mark at this point a year ago (*more below*).

STREAKING REBELS

Ole Miss enters the weekend on a nine-game winning streak, tying a three-year-old school record. The Rebels have batted .410 during the streak and outscored their opponents, 73-9. The UM hurlers have helped out with a 0.86 staff ERA and four shutouts. Perhaps the key to Ole Miss' improved play has been the emergence of **Nicole Alger**. The freshman from Tulsa, Okla., has led the squad over the last nine games, batting .577 with five doubles, two homers and 12 RBI. She has also recorded a 2-0 record on the mound with a 0.58 ERA and a shutout. The Rebels now try to turn their three-game SEC win streak into another record. Ole Miss has never won more than four consecutive league games.

RECORD-BREAKING POWER SURGE

The 2002 Rebels are ripping the ball out of the park and destroying the UM record book in the process. With 21 home runs as a team, the Rebels have already surpassed the club total of the previous two seasons combined, including the for-

mer single-season high of nine set in 2000. The current Ole Miss squad broke that record in this season's 17th contest - game one of the Tennessee series, in which the Rebels blasted three round-trippers to set a new single-game standard. That matchup also saw **DeDe Justice** establish a new individual season record with her sixth homer. The freshman catcher now boasts nine and needs only three more to eclipse UM career-leader Heather Swinney's 11 bombs. Ole Miss currently ranks fourth in the SEC in home runs as a team, while Justice is fifth individually (*more below*).

CAREER HIGHS ... ALREADY

Junior **Phyllis Manley** has recorded 10 RBI, exceeding the combined total of six from her first two years in Oxford ... After only one win in four starts a year ago, junior righthander **Leslie Day** has already notched seven wins this season, including her first three career shutouts. She also picked up her first ever save in the 3-2 Central Florida victory ... Sophomore outfielder **Britte Hardy** boasts five stolen bases (in six attempts) after swiping only two in 2001 ... Making her 10th start of the year in the UK series, junior righthander **Lindsay Price** earned her fifth win, matching her career-high set in 2001.

TOURNEY CHAMPS

Ole Miss collected a pair of tournament titles this season. The Rebels captured first place at the season-opening UNM Diamond Invitational in Albuquerque, N.M., as well as taking the crown at their own tourney, the Rebel/Easton Invitational.

GREATEST COMEBACK

In the Rebels' 10-9 season-opening win over New Mexico, Ole Miss rallied from its largest deficit ever, coming back from 6-0 down to win in 11 innings, which also tied the longest game in Rebel history.
