REBELS HIT ROAD FOR GEORGIA

Ole Miss looks to end its SEC road woes this weekend in a three-game set with Georgia in Athens. The Rebels (24-21, 6-15 SEC) enter the series two games out of the eighth and final spot for the SEC Tournament and matched up with a Bulldog squad (45-11, 13-11 SEC) that sits fourth and ranked No. 25 in the nation. Ole Miss will be looking for its first conference road win of the year, falling to 0-9 after sweeps at Tennessee, Auburn and Mississippi State. However, the Rebels have been strong against the SEC Eastern Division, taking two of three East series (Kentucky and Florida).

SERIES INFO

The Rebel-Bulldog all-time series is one of the tightest in the league, with UGA maintaining a slight 6-5 advantage (*more below*). The visiting team has earned the series win the past three years. Georgia swept a 1999 doubleheader in Oxford and took two-of-three in 2001, while Ole Miss claimed both games of a 2000 twin bill in Athens, including a UM record-tying 11-inning contest. The Dogs captured the first two games of last year's

set, but dropped the finale on a four-hit shutout by Rebel hurler Jennifer Hughes. **Jessica Hamilton** drove in two runs in the game.

LAST TIME OUT

The Rebels suffered their second home series loss of the season last weekend, dropping two-of-three to West-rival Arkansas. The lone Ole Miss victory came in game two on the heroics of **Desiree Layman**. With the game tied in the seventh inning, Layman doubled to right-center field, allowing **Brooke Turner** to score from first just ahead of the relay at the plate. The 3-2 victory ended a season-long seven-game skid. **Lindsey Whatley** hurled her third consecutive complete game in the win. In the opener, Ole Miss endured its third 1-0 loss in a week as **Leslie Day** came out on the short end against Heather Schlichtman. **DeDe Justice**'s 10th homer of the year was not enough in the 5-2 game-three loss. Schlichtman registered her second win of the series, in addition to notching her first career homer as part of a UA three-run rally in the second inning.

SCOUTING REPORT

With a school-record 45 wins under its belt, Georgia returned home Sunday night from a six-day road trip that saw the Bulldogs split six games with SEC East rivals South Carolina and Florida. The Dogs, who have risen as high as 20th in the national rankings this year, took one-of-three in Columbia before beating Florida two-of-three at Gainesville. In game three at USC, Nichole Urban pitched a career-high 10 innings as Georgia salvaged the finale, 2-1. For the week Urban pitched two complete games, throwing 17 innings with 11 strikeouts and her first shutout since blanking Marshall, 6-0, on February 9. Nicole Barber hit .500 for the week with three stolen bases and two triples. With three steals in three attempts last week, Barber upped her season total of stolen bases to 54-for-54. Dating back to last season she has 65 consecutive successful stolen bases, just four off the all-time NCAA record. Urban leads the team at the plate with a .415 average.

TOUGH-LUCK LADIES

While the Rebel offense has struggled during the three straight series losses, the Ole Miss pitching staff has remained solid with a 2.57 ERA over the nine-game

stretch. The Rebels have been on the short end of three 1-0 pitchers' duels, including two in the Mississippi State series. Junior **Leslie Day** was the tough luck loser in the openers of both the MSU and Arkansas series. **Lindsey Whatley** scattered six hits and the game's lone run in the State finale. Despite a 1-2 mark, Whatley has surrendered only three earned runs in her last three starts -- all complete games -- while registering a 0.94 ERA. The Rebels have been held scoreless in five of the six losses for the freshman righthander from Huntsville, Ala.

STREAKING REBELS

The 2002 season has been one of streaks for Ole Miss. The Rebels have had five stretches of four or more wins or losses. They opened the season winning four-in-a-row, earning the program's first ever 4-0 start. From Mar. 16-Mar. 26, Ole Miss recorded a nine-game winning streak, tying a three-year-old school record. The Rebels batted .410 during the streak and outscored their opponents, 73-9. However, the Rebels suffered through four-game skids immediately prior to and following the record nine-game run. Ole Miss recently ended a season-long seven-game losing streak.

STRICTLY CONFERENCE

It's SEC only for Ole Miss for the remainder of its 2002 schedule. The Rebels are facing the fourth of seven straight conference series, including five against teams that have been ranked in the nation's top 25, leading up to the SEC Tournament, May 9-12 in Chattanooga, Tenn.

BEST SEASON YET

The Rebels remain in the midst of the best season in the program's six-year history. Ole Miss needs only three more victories to surpass the school record for wins in a season set in 1999. That year also marked the only other time the Rebels have maintained an above .500 mark this late in the year. With the Mar. 26 sweep of Jackson State, Ole Miss reached the 20-win plateau faster than any previous UM team. Proof of the turnaround is visible in the unprecedented statistics. The single-season school record for homers fell after only 17 games, and now the season highs for runs (15 away), and RBI (12 away) are in sight. The club is also on pace to set new standard for earned run average (currently 48 points lower at 1.96). In addition, the Rebels set or tied UM single-game records for hits, runs and RBI in the 20-0 shellacking of JSU, which also gave Ole Miss its record-tying ninth-straight win.

POWER SURGE

The 2002 Rebels are ripping the ball out of the park and destroying the UM record book in the process. With 23

home runs as a team, the Rebels have already exceeded the club total of the previous two seasons combined, including the former single-season high of nine set in 2000. The current Ole Miss squad broke that record in this season's 17th contest - game one of the Tennessee series, in which the Rebels blasted three round-trippers to set a new single-game standard. That matchup also saw **DeDe Justice** establish a new individual season record with her sixth homer. The freshman catcher now boasts 10 and needs only two more to eclipse UM career-leader Heather Swinney's 11 bombs. Ole Miss entered the week tied for fourth in the SEC in home runs as a team, while Justice ranks fifth individually.

CAREER HIGHS ... ALREADY

Junior **Phyllis Manley** has recorded 10 RBI, exceeding the combined total of six from her first two years in Oxford ... Sophomore outfielder **Britte Hardy** boasts eight stolen bases (in 10 attempts) after swiping only two in 2001 ... In the UK series, junior righthander **Lindsay Price** earned her fifth victory, matching her season-high for wins set in 2001.

TOURNEY CHAMPS

Ole Miss collected a pair of tournament titles this season. The Rebels captured first place at the season-opening UNM Diamond Invitational in Albuquerque, N.M., as well as taking the crown at their own tourney, the Rebel/Easton Invitational.
